This is How We Fight Our Battles

Community Group Questions

1. *A major theme of the Bible is that God wins battles for us that we can't win for ourselves. What is a battle from your story where you see that God has won and/or is winning on your behalf?*
2. *Another major theme of the Bible is that God calls us to fight alongside him in many battles—battles against sin, or against human systems that set themselves up apart from God, and even battles against the devil and his demons. What are the good ways in which you “pick up the fight”? See Ephesians 6 if you want some ideas to get going. Think at a heart level— what do you think are some good “postures of the heart” to have in fighting evil alongside God?*
3. *Lastly, the Bible is clear that we will battle our own sin until the Lord returns or calls us to heaven. What is a battle against sin that you are currently engaged in or need to engage in? What are your weapons against it?*

The Bible teaches that on a powerful day in the future, God will defeat the devil and win the battle against sin and sadness in the world. What is something that you are looking forward to about that day?

Call to Communion

Guidelines for the Reception of Communion

Redeemer welcomes to Communion all Christians who are willing to forsake their sin and trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and who are members of congregations which proclaim the gospel. We will be coming forward for the distribution of Communion. Please use the hand sanitizer. You will receive the bread into your hands and take a cup from the tray. Clear cups (located in the interior rings) contain grape juice. Red cups (exterior ring of tray) contain wine. Wait to eat the bread and drink the wine until we all do so together, once we are back in our seats. Children who have been interviewed by the elders are able to share in Communion.

Communion is a time of connection with the Lord Jesus and with each other. Feel free to sing with the band during Communion. The ministry of prayer is also a way we live together as a community of believers and seekers. Please take the time to pray on your own, or with someone else in the pews.
